## Waste and Recycling

North Castle recycling law requires every individual, business, organization and institution to source separate:

Waste

Cardboard and paper

Glass, aluminum and plastics  thru 

All waste and recycling material must be available by 7:00 am on collection days.

Waste and recycling containers **must not** be larger than 32 gallons.

### Curbside pickup:

- Waste and recycling containers cannot be left on the street and must be within 4 feet of the curb.
- Containers shall not be placed at the curb any earlier than 4 pm prior to pickup and must be removed no later than 12 hours after collection.
- All waste and recycling containers must be in good repair.

### Backdoor pickup:

- Backdoor waste and recycling collection will be made only when the driveway is free of all snow, vehicles and other obstacles.
- Only the driver can determine if the driveway can be negotiated safely.
- If your driveway is inaccessible, please put your waste and recycling at the curb that day.

Backdoor service and twice-weekly pickups are available for a fee. For more information, call Suburban Carting at 914-698-4300.

## Waste

- All waste must be in sturdy plastic bags, and placed in watertight receptacles.
- Household paint cans must be dried before collection. Harden paint by mixing with kitty litter or another absorbent pellet material. After paint is hardened, place can and lid separately at curbside.
- Carpeting must be cut into pieces no wider than 3 feet.

### Bulk and large item pickup:

- Residents must call Suburban Carting at 914-698-4300 before placing items at curbside.
- Refers to household items only.
- Bulk and large items must not be wider than 3 feet.
- Must be at the curb by 7:00 am.
- Shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 3 days prior to your pickup day.
- No bulk pickup during holiday weeks.

### The following items are not accepted for curbside bulk and large item pickup:

- chemicals
- fencing
- windows
- tires
- trees/leaves/grass
- used oil
- batteries
- stone
- tree stumps
- construction debris of any kind
- bricks
- masonry
- lumber
- logs
- propane tanks

### The following items are considered waste and are not recyclable:

- styrofoam/packing peanuts
- wax-coated milk and food containers
- frozen food containers
- pottery
- china/crystal

## Cardboard and Paper

### You must recycle:

- newspaper, magazines, paper bags
- phonebooks, catalogs, junk mail
- corrugated cardboard boxes (remove tape and styrofoam)
- cereal, pasta, gift, shoe boxes
- shredded paper (place in clear bags)
- office paper, envelopes

### How to prepare cardboard and paper for pickup:

- Place items directly in your clearly marked recycling bin.
- **Recycling** stickers are available at Town Hall.
- No need to break down large boxes. Stack smaller boxes within larger boxes.
- **Do not put paper items in plastic bags.** The only exception is shredded paper in clear plastic bags.



## Glass, Aluminum and Plastics thru

All items must be cleaned and residue free.

### You must recycle:

- glass bottles
- aluminum foil
- metal and plastic bottle caps
- cans, including empty aerosol cans
- all plastics  thru 

### How to prepare glass, aluminum cans and plastics for pickup:

- Place items directly in your clearly marked recycling bin.
- No plastic bag necessary. **Recycling** stickers are available at Town Hall.
- **or**
- Place items in clear or blue recycling bags.
- Do not use white or black bags for recycling; drivers will mistake recycling items for waste.
